
- Use the Chat bubble icon at the top of the screen

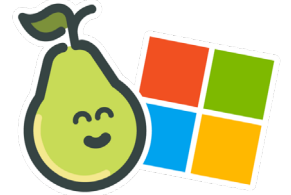

Pear Deck™

Using Pear Deck:

1. **Create a slideshow (Google Slides, Power Point)**
2. **Open “Pear Deck” from the “Add-ons” drop down menu**
 - a. **Sidebar gives access to interactive slides**
 - i. ***Template Library*** - Premade Pear Deck slides (editable)
 - ii. ***Ask Students a Question*** - Turn a non PD slide into a specialty slide
3. **Launch the Pear Deck by clicking on “Start Lesson”**
 - a. **Generates a code**
4. **Students go to “JOINPD.COM” and enter code**
5. **Students & Instructor stay connected to meeting platform for sound but interact with the slides in another tab or on another screen**

Pear Deck: Pros and Cons

Pros:

- **Synchronous or Asynchronous (Instructor paced vs. Student-paced)**
- **Visually engaging & interactive**
- **Enhances participation**
- **Makes it easier for quieter youth to participate & “use their voice”**
- **Student responses - anonymous**
- **Embed clickable links**

Cons:

- **Isn't always conducive to group discussion (serves better as a springboard)**
- **Requires toggling between different tabs**
- **Can be slow to launch**
- **Can seem a little “young” in slide design (may not work well with seniors +)**

Types of Slides

- **Text**
 - Youth respond with a typed answer
 - Responses can be anonymous during lesson
- **Multiple Choice**
 - Students choose from pre-set list of answers
- **Webslides**
 - Embed links to other sites: Kahoot, FlipGrid, YouTube, TedTalk, etc.
- **Instructions**
- **Draggable**
- **Drawing**

Text Slides

- **Turn a regular slide into a “Text Slide”**
 - **Students are prompted and asked for a response**
- **Edit by going to the “Ask Students a Question” in the Pear Deck sidebar and selecting “Text”**

- **Turn a regular slide into a “Multiple Choice Slide”**
 - **Students are prompted to choose from a limited selection of answers**
- **Edit by going to the “Ask Students a Question” in the Pear Deck sidebar and selecting “Choice”**

Websites

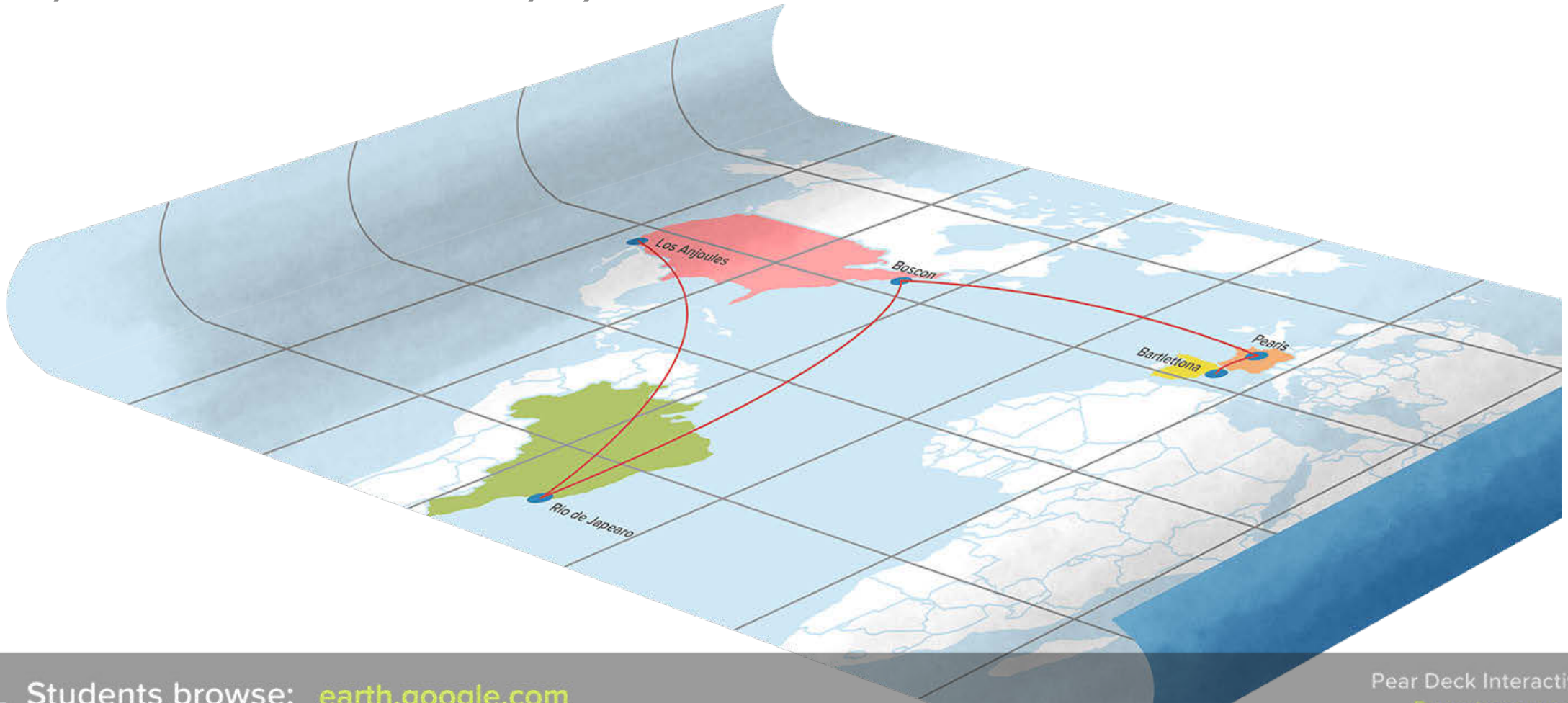
- **Turn a regular slide into a “Webslide”**
 - **Students are prompted to click on a link taking them to another site**
- **Edit the type of question by going to the “Ask Students a Question” in the Pear Deck sidebar and selecting “Website”**

Flipgrid: Video Response Platform



Using Flipgrid:

1. **Create a discussion Topic**
2. **Share it with your learning community**
 - a. **No login required**
 - b. **Teens are given a link**
3. **Learners record and share short videos with you and your class**

Flipgrid: Pros and Cons

Pros:

- Provides teens the opportunity to share in their own unique and creative way
- Teens enjoy making personal video, similar to Tik-Tok or IG Story
- Can be done synchronous and asynchronous
- FG provides a ton of support
- It is FREE!!!

Cons:

- Not much dialogue (at least we have not used it)
- Assignment description must be very clear
- Not all teens are comfortable recording themselves
 - Filters; Stickers
- Time limit:
 - Make sure to put time limits on videos
 - Time to create videos will vary for each teen

Kahoot!: Game-Based Learning Platform



Using Kahoot:

- 1. Create a Kahoot account**
- 2. Create a Kahoot**
 - a. Can be mix of poll questions, quizzes, true or false questions or puzzles**
- 3. Teens login using the Kahoot App or Website and Pin number**

Kahoot!: Pros and Cons

Pros:

- **Teens enjoy the game like style**
- **Quick and efficient full group participation**
- **Can be used for fun or education**
- **Thousands of quizzes to choose from**
- **You can design your own, unique quiz**
- **Does not require login for teens**

Cons:

- **No discussion options within the tool**
- **Free version is very limited**
 - **We use the pro subscription**
- **Must be done on a laptop/computer or two screens (Phone and Ipad or tablet)**



At a Party

Setting the Stage:
