

TPP Program Fidelity Monitoring Quick Reference Glossary

This glossary captures commonly used terms related to Teen Pregnancy Prevention (TPP) Program fidelity. Staff can reference this sheet as they complete the *Introduction to Fidelity eLearning* and as they apply fidelity concepts to their work.

ROLES

Facilitator

Someone trained to implement the program model. For example, a health educator, youth leader, or parent/caregiver engagement specialist.

Grantee organization

Organization receiving TPP Program funding from OPA.

Implementing organization

Partner organization associated with the grantee that delivers TPP programming. For example, schools or community-based organizations. Some grantees serve as their own implementing organizations.

Observer

Someone who attends program sessions and is neither a facilitator nor a participant. For example, a program administrator, quality improvement specialist, or evaluator.

Program administrator

Someone in charge of TPP project management and/or implementation. For example, a project director, program director, project manager, or project coordinator.

IMPLEMENTATION

Activity

How a specific program model is implemented during a given session. Activities may include but aren't limited to discussions, games, and role plays.

Program model

The effective or promising intervention being implemented. Grantees may have one or more program models associated with their project.

Section

A group of participants who receive and complete the program at the same time and in the same location.

Session

Each meeting of the group (section) of participants.

FIDELITY MONITORING

Dosage

How much of a program a participant attended.

Fidelity

The degree to which a program is implemented with adherence to its core components—the key ingredients related to achieving the outcomes associated with the program model.

Reach

Number of participants in a section (implementation group) who attended at least one activity.
